There are Two Ways of Driving: Defensively or Non-Defensively

- When you drive defensively you take control of the driving situation.
- When you drive non-defensively, you do not control the driving situation.
- Drivers have little to no control over the actions of pedestrians and other drivers; however, defensive drivers will signal to them with lights, turn signals, and horn.
- Driving defensively means signaling at all times – when turning, pulling into a bus stop or putting on your flashers well in advance at a railroad crossing.
- Pedestrians, bicyclists and children won't be watching for you, you have to watch out for them.
