Railroad Crossing Safety

It only takes a moment to set yourself up properly for a safe crossing. Here are some tips to ensure you and your passengers remain safe:

- Assess the crossing as you approach it. Position yourself for best visibility of the tracks.
- Communicate your intention to stop well in advance, at least 200 feet.
- Keep your foot on the service brake.



Look and listen...LOOK and LISTEN...LOOK AND LISTEN!

- Rock and Roll around vision obstructions and track design.
- Avoid rushing.
- Always approach tracks expecting a train!

Make the right choice about crossing safely.

Once you are certain no train is approaching, you are clear to move across the tracks safely.

If in doubt: Do Not Move & Call for Assistance!
