Bus Yard Safety

To ensure everyone's safety, pedestrians and drivers must remain on high alert while walking and working in the yard.

Observe Traffic Patterns

Here's what you need to do to be safe in the yard:

- Be aware and attentive of your surroundings and possible hazards.
- Avoid clothing and actions that may inhibit your awareness such as:
 - ✓ Hoods, hats, scarves and umbrellas – may inhibit your vision
 - ✓ Cell phones – talking/texting while walking may cause inattention blindness
 - ✓ Ear buds or ear phones – inhibit your hearing
- Be seen - Always wear your high-visibility vest as your last outer garment.
- Look in the direction you are walking – watch your step, but keep your eyes moving in all directions.
- If you hear a back-up beeper, identify the direction and vehicle it is coming from.
- Use marked pathways when they are available.

Safety in the bus yard is a shared responsibility – as you are walking through the yard, be aware of and yield to moving vehicles.
