Don't Crack the Eggs!

Hard braking and passenger fall events happen when:

- 1. You do not project your eyes further down the road to recognize any potential approaching hazards.
- 2. You fail to maintain a 6 second following distance with the vehicle in front of you.

By not projecting your eyes and not maintaining a 6 second following distance, you **will** hard brake, thus making your customers feel very unsafe with your driving.

Drive as though you have eggs rolling on the seats of your bus - you don't want to crack any of them! Allow yourself enough time and space for an easy brake....
